THE 2012-2013 PAST SEASON REVIEW

Musically the 2012-13 season has been a great success, with outstanding performances from Alan Barnes, Chris Garrick & John Etheridge, Benny Sharoni and Adam Glasser, with Jim Hart and Trudy Kerr not far behind. Locals Casey Green, Graham Dent and the Jazz Jam attracted slightly fewer people, but also provided good music. Financially, the club made a small loss overall, explicable in part by the need to replace an amplifier and by higher printing costs. Attendance was slightly down on average compared with previous years, whilst membership remained steady. Our membership has been remarkably faithful and steady over the years, and Members have been highly appreciative of our efforts to provide a high quality programme. **BUT** we would like to see a few more of you at each gig, together with friends and relatives, as well as extra Non-Members who are always welcome. In particular we would like to see some younger people coming into the club: new blood is always welcome! Whilst at the moment Harborough Jazz is in good health musically and financially, times are hard all round; just 5 to 10 more people at each gig would make all the difference.

THE 2013-2014 COMING SEASON

We believe that we have lined up the best programme possible for the 2013-2014 season, whilst keeping entry prices and membership fees at the same levels as the last two years. The season kicks off in September with local band the Andy Nicholls Quintet. In October trumpeter Steve Waterman plays a tribute to Buddy Bolden, supported by Anthony Kerr on vibes and Alec Dankworth on bass. November sees the return of U S altoist Greg Abate, with the Nick Hislam Trio, whilst December brings back the great singer Andra Sparks with her outstanding group including Nicki Iles on keyboards, Art Themen on tenor, and newcomer Laura Judd on trumpet. January will give us The Great Wee Band with one of Harborough Jazz's favourites, guitarist Jim Mullen, together with the wonderful Henry Lowther on trumpet, Dave Green on bass and Stu Butterfield on drums. February sees tenor player Josh Kemp stop off at Harborough as part of his group's UK tour, whilst March sees a possible tenor battle between Art Themen alongside Don Weller. April is a little quieter with trombonist Annie Whitehead's quartet, and May should see a rousing session with drummer Clark Tracey's new quintet....and the season finishes with Dr Len Holden's annual jazz jam featuring some of the best of our local musicians.
