#### Ticket Prices

#### General

In the event of rain, there is a marquee available; HOWEVER only those who have bought the first two hundred tickets will have access to the marquee.

As a result of what we learnt last year, we intend to start and finish earlier. Gates to the car park will open at **12.00 noon**. You will need to bring your own food and drink.

Inevitably, there are the usual conditions, as follows.  
Please do not bring gazebos, high-backed chairs or tables.  
No games will be allowed. Children must be supervised by an adult at all times.

Please support us in this venture; buy lots and lots of tickets!  
Once again this is fantastic value for money; three gigs, at least 4½ hours of jazz and at an average price of £6.67 per gig if you buy in advance, and £7.67 if you buy on the day!

#### No Tickets

Those of you who have attended the last two gigs will have noticed that we no longer print and issue tickets. (Tickets will be available for JOASDA.) We issued questionnaires at the two previous gigs to get your views about this as a proposal, and the overwhelming response was that it was thought to be a good idea. This has taken away an administrative burden from your volunteer Committee, and in the future will in a small way reduce the stationery costs.

#### Advance Bookings

The fact that we no longer issue tickets does not affect a Member's ability to book in advance. We have simply changed the name of the relevant document to Advance Booking Voucher. The system still works, as was proved at the last two gigs. Simply send your cheque for one or two bookings to us as before. You will be placed on the Admission Sales Schedule and checked in on arrival at the gig.

Note that we will never confirm your booking; we will only contact you if we are unable to accommodate you. If you want to check that we have received your booking, please call us.

The figures given throughout are as compared with the 1<sup>st</sup> half of last season.

The total audience is **up** to 294 from 235. The average size of the audience is **up** to 59 from 47. This is an **increase** of 25%.

The average audience comprises Members 49% (45%), Guests 32% (31%), M&G thus 81% (76%), and Non-Members 19% (24%). (Figures for last season are in brackets.)

The number of Non-Members attending remains the same at 56. Thus the increase in size of the audience has been driven by Members and Guests. We need Non-Members to attend; the more the better. Please encourage your friends and other jazz enthusiasts to come along. Harborough Jazz is not exclusive and is open to all. **Non-Members are *always* welcome.**
